



Hornsby Junction Remodelling and Commuter Car Park

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

October 2016

The Hornsby Junction Remodelling and Commuter Car Park includes building a new multi-storey commuter car park at Hornsby Station and upgrading rail infrastructure in the area to increase the capacity and reliability of the T1 North Shore Line.

This project is being delivered by the Novo Rail alliance on behalf of Transport for NSW.

Trackwork weekend – Saturday 29 and Sunday 30 October

Work will be undertaken in and around the rail corridor at Hornsby Station during a trackwork weekend from **6pm Friday 28 to 6am Monday 31 October**. Work activities will include:

- staff using handheld surveying equipment and drilling holes to sample soil
- excavation and concreting footings of overhead wiring structures
- installation and removal of ballast (rocks and gravel around the rail line)
- delivery and pick up of ballast from the rail corridor at the Government Road access gate
- installation of temporary site buildings at the northern end of the George Street commuter car park. This area will be marked off with site fencing for the safety of pedestrians and motorists.
- early morning deliveries within the rail corridor at the Government Road and Railway Parade access gates.

Work will also be undertaken by RCR O'Donnell Griffin as part of the Power Supply Upgrade Program during this time. Work activities include the installation of new cable routes in and around the Hornsby Substation on Jersey Street, and within the rail corridor. This work will occur from **6am Saturday 29 to 4am Monday 31 October**.

To ensure the safety of customers and staff, this work will be completed during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend when fewer trains are operating. Train services will be affected during these times. Please contact **Transport Info** on **131 500** or visit **transport.nsw.info** for more information about bus replacement services.

Temporary closure of car parking spaces

Approximately 110 car parking spaces in the George Street commuter car park will be unavailable from **6pm Friday 28 to 6am Monday 31 October**. This is to allow for a project site office to be set up and construction equipment to be stored. Access to the car park will be maintained at all times and traffic control will be in place. Alternative parking will be available at Hornsby TAFE on Jersey Street, Hornsby during this time.

Weekday deliveries

Between **8am and 6pm Thursday 27 and Friday 28 October** deliveries of materials to the rail corridor will take place via the access gates on Government Road and Hornsby Street.

Traffic impacts

To ensure the safety of pedestrians and motorists, traffic control and signage will be in place between Thursday 27 October and Monday 31 October.

What you may notice

Construction noise

Equipment to be used includes a compactor, concrete trucks, semi-trailers, delivery trucks, sucker trucks, excavators, drilling and piling rigs, light vehicles, lighting towers, concrete saw and power tools and hand tools.

Some of this work may generate noise, however we will take every possible step to minimise noise such as switching off equipment when it is not in use and regular noise monitoring will be undertaken to ensure noise levels are managed.

Traffic and pedestrian access

Workers will access the rail corridor via gates at Government Road, Hornsby Street, Railway Parade and the George Street commuter car park. Traffic control will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists and pedestrians. Please follow directions and proceed carefully.
