



Hornsby Junction Remodelling and Commuter Car Park

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

December 2016

The Hornsby Junction Remodelling and Commuter Car Park includes building a new multi-storey commuter car park at Hornsby Station and upgrading rail infrastructure in the area to increase the capacity and reliability of the T1 North Shore Line.

This project is being delivered by the Novo Rail alliance on behalf of Transport for NSW.

Weeknight and weekend trackwork - Tuesday 6 to Tuesday 13 December

Work will be carried out in and around the rail corridor at Hornsby Station as part of the remodelling of Hornsby Junction from **7pm Tuesday 6 to 7pm Tuesday 13 December**. Work activities include:

- removal of concrete and brick staff access ramp near Platform 1
- installation of temporary fencing and removal of some rail corridor fencing
- installation of temporary site buildings at the northern end of the George Street commuter car park. This area will be marked off with site fencing for the safety of pedestrians and motorists
- vegetation management and tree trimming to ensure safe working
- excavation and concreting footings for overhead wiring structures
- installation and removal of ballast (rocks and gravel around the rail line)
- night time work within the rail corridor near Alexandria Parade, George Street, High Street, Railway Parade and Hornsby Street
- early morning deliveries within the rail corridor at the Hornsby Street and Railway Parade access gates will take place on Saturday 10 and Sunday 11 December.

To ensure the safety of customers and staff, this work will be completed during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend when fewer trains are operating.

Temporary closure of car parking spaces

Up to 90 car parking spaces in the George Street commuter car park will be unavailable from **7pm Tuesday 6 to 7pm Tuesday 13 December**. This is to allow for construction work to be carried out safely midweek. It will also allow for a temporary project site office to be set up and construction equipment to be stored during the trackwork weekend.

Access to the car park will be maintained at all times and traffic control will be in place. **Alternative parking will be available at Hornsby TAFE on Jersey Street during this time** (please see map overleaf).

Weekday deliveries

Between **7am and 6pm Wednesday 7 and Friday 9 December** deliveries of materials to the rail corridor will take place via the access gates on Hornsby Street and Railway Parade and through the George Street commuter car park.

Between **6am Monday 12 and 6pm Tuesday 13 December** work vehicles will access the George Street commuter car park as the site is dismantled and car spaces are gradually returned to the car park.

What you may notice

Traffic impacts

To ensure the safety of pedestrians and motorists, traffic control and signage will be in place between Tuesday 6 and Tuesday 13 December.

Construction noise

Equipment to be used includes a compactor, concrete trucks, a dump truck, semi-trailers, delivery trucks, sucker trucks, a small crane, a road sweeper, excavators, light vehicles, lighting towers, concrete saws and power tools and hand tools.

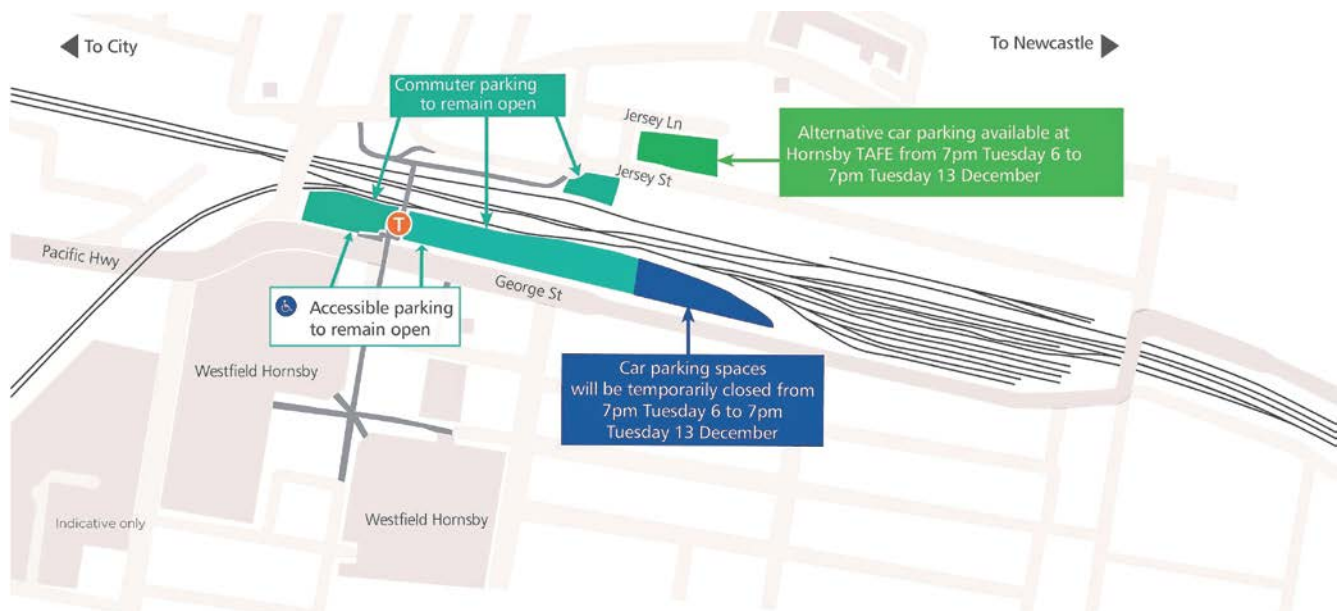
Some of this work may generate noise, however we will take every possible step to minimise noise such as switching off equipment when it is not in use and regular noise monitoring will be undertaken to ensure noise levels are managed.

Traffic and pedestrian access

Workers will access the rail corridor via gates at Government Road, Hornsby Street, Railway Parade and the George Street commuter car park. Traffic control will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists and pedestrians. Please follow directions and proceed carefully.
