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This E57 Community Consultation Report provides a summary of consultation undertaken in accordance with Condition of Approval (CoA) E57 with respect to Out-of-hours Work (OOHW) activities proposed at the Footbridge St Marys site.

OOHW is required to carry out activities within the rail corridor, which can only occur during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period. An OOHW application has been submitted to the Project Environmental Representative (ER) for approval before the work commences. The application includes a detailed outline of the construction activities, methodology, assessment of potential noise impacts, and a schedule of the required works.

The OOHW application will be reviewed and endorsed by the Sydney Metro Director of Project Communications and the Project Environmental Representative prior to works commencing.

1.1 OOHW activities include.

- Removal of falsework and scaffold
- Mobilise materials on and off platforms
- Mobilise reinforcement onto platforms
- Edge protection installation on planks
- Precast plank installation
- Harris St Compound (32-34 Harris St), SSTOM Compound, Harris Street laydown (2 Harris Street), Laydown 1 (opposite Pacific National 20m south of Terminal Access Road), and Glossop St laydown will be utilised to support the above activities, use of the site office, and materials storage and stockpiling. Harris St laydown, and Glossop St laydown will be utilised if Laydown 1 becomes full.
- All plant accessing from Glossop Street laydown, Laydown 1, Harris St compound and SSTOM compound.

1.2 Work period.

The proposed works will be carried out between 01:00 on Saturday 5 July and 04:00 on Monday 7 July, during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork period.

2. Conditions of Approval E57 - Community Consultation on Respite

Condition of Approval E57 states: To undertake out-of-hours work outside the work hours specified under Condition E38, appropriate respite periods for the out-of-hours work must be identified in consultation with the community at each affected location on a regular basis. This consultation must include (but not be limited to) providing the community with:

- (a) a progressive schedule for periods no less than three (3) months, of likely out-of-hours work;
- (b) a description of the potential work, location, and duration of the out-of-hours work;
- (c) the noise characteristics and likely noise levels of the work; and
- (d) likely mitigation and management measures which aim to achieve the relevant noise management levels (NMLs) under Condition E43 (including the circumstances of when respite or relocation offers will be available and details about how the affected community can access these offers).

The outcomes of the community consultation, the identified respite periods and the scheduling of the likely out-of-hour work must be provided to the ER, EPA and the Planning Secretary prior to the out-of-hours work commencing.

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Note: Respite periods can be any combination of days or hours where out-of-hours work would not be more than 5 dB(A) above the RBL at any residence.

In accordance with the Sydney Metro Construction Noise and Vibration Standard (CNVS), the Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan (CNVMP), and the Detailed Noise and Vibration Impact Statements (DNVIS), all noise-affected receivers are eligible for respite periods during out-of-hours activities when works are predicted to exceed the Noise Management Levels (NMLs) during evening and night-time periods.

2.1 Eligible properties

Respite has been triggered at the following 29 properties:

- 47-49 Kalang Avenue
- 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15 Camira Street
- 75 Carinya Avenue

3. Consultation Tools and Channels

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3.1 Hardcopy notification

The hardcopy notification detailing the OOHW to be carried out between 1:00 on Saturday 5 July and 4:00 on Monday 7 July was delivered by letterbox on Tuesday, 24 June 2025. Total letterboxes reached: 579.

3.2 Online notification

A link to the online notification was emailed to the St Marys distribution list via the communications management system (Consultation Manager) on Tuesday, 24 June 2025.

3.3 OOHW three-month lookahead

A three-month OOHW lookahead is included in each monthly notification. The table below was included in the June community notification.

July 2025

Transport for NSW is delivering a new footbridge and northern plaza at St Marys Station as part of the Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project.

Work activities in July

- lifting in new footbridge concrete beams across the train tracks
- excavating and installing utility services, such as water and sewer on Harris Street and near the multi-storey car park (up to 10 parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable during this work)
- delivering and removing materials and equipment via Hobart Street, Harris Street, Glossop Street, and Forrester Road
- continuing electrical, hydraulic, excavation and concrete work on all station platforms and within the Harris Street work area.

What to expect

- workers and vehicles in and around work sites, laydown areas, and station platforms
- traffic control and signs as needed
- construction equipment in use including excavators, saw cutters, trucks, cranes, concrete pumps, power tools, and survey equipment.

When and where we'll be working

Standard working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

In **July**, work to install more concrete beams will take place continuously during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork weekend from **1am Saturday 5 July to 4am Monday 7 July**.

Subject to approvals, we will be working extended hours from:

- **6pm to 7am between Tuesday 1 July and Friday 4 July**
- **7am to 3pm on Saturday 12 July, Saturday 19 July and Saturday 26 July**
- **6pm to 7am between Monday 14 July and Tuesday 29 July.**

Material deliveries will also occur between **6pm and 12am on Friday 4 July**.

Please refer to the map on the next page showing our work areas and parking impacts.

Managing our impacts

We aim to minimise impacts on the community and environment by:

- installing safety and security fencing around our work areas
- reducing noise by turning off machinery when not in use and using noise barriers where we can.

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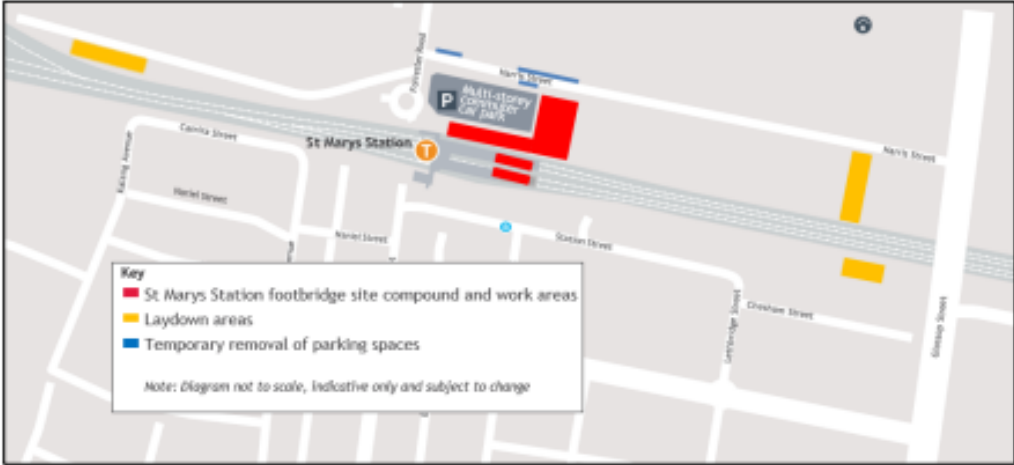
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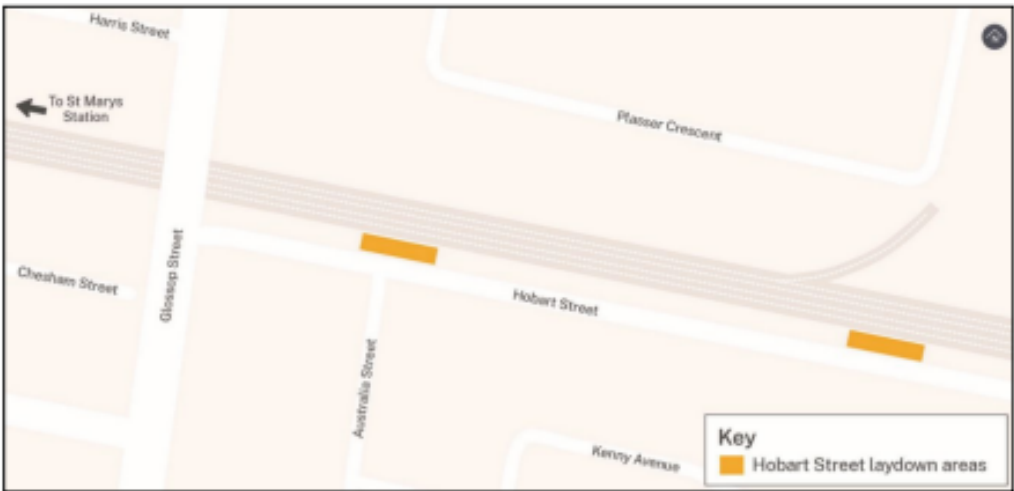

Dear Resident

Transport for NSW is delivering a new footbridge and northern plaza at St Marys Station as part of the Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project.

From 1am Saturday 5 July until 4am Monday 7 July, we will be working continuously during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork weekend. Planned activities include adjusting platform hoarding, removing temporary support structures, installing concrete planks and delivering materials.

We will be working in multiple areas, including Harris Street, Forrester Road, the station platforms, within the rail corridor, and in the Sydney Metro site compound on Station Street to use the tower crane. Work will also take place near the multi-storey commuter car park on Harris Street.

Laydown areas will be used to store construction materials and equipment and will be located within the rail corridor off Forrester Road, off Glossop Street, and on Hobart Street.

Offer of respite

Where work is required outside standard construction hours, a noise assessment is prepared in accordance with the project's planning approval. We have done a noise assessment for the planned weekend work and understand there may be noisy work near your property. For this reason, we would like to offer you respite from the predicted noise impact of construction work in line with the Construction Noise and Vibration Standard on individual properties.

In line with the project's Detailed Noise and Vibration Impact Statement, each person in your household is eligible for three \$25 entertainment vouchers (for cinemas, Zone Bowling, or Timezone) for work occurring on Saturday 5 July and Sunday 6 July 2025.
