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This E57 Community Consultation Report provides a summary of consultation undertaken in accordance with Condition of Approval (CoA) E57 with respect to Out-of-hours Work (OOHW) activities proposed at the Footbridge St Marys site.

OOHW is required to carry out activities within the rail corridor, which can only occur during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period. An OOHW application has been submitted to the Project Environmental Representative (ER) for approval before the work commences. The application includes a detailed outline of the construction activities, methodology, assessment of potential noise impacts, and a schedule of the required works.

The OOHW application will be reviewed and endorsed by the Sydney Metro Director of Project Communications and the Project Environmental Representative prior to works commencing.

1.1 OOHW activities include.

- Excavating and backfilling in work areas
- Asphalt reinstatement
- Investigating, installing and relocating utility services
- Installing steel, lift, soffits and canopy parts
- Concrete patching and painting
- Removing redundant infrastructure and services
- Delivery and removal of equipment and materials.
- Harris St Compound (32-34 Harris St), Harris Street laydown (2 Harris Street) and Glossop St laydown will be utilised to support the above activities, use of the site office, and materials storage and stockpiling.
- All plant accessing from Glossop Street laydown and Harris St compound.

1.2 Work period.

The proposed works will be carried out during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork periods between 02:00 on Saturday 14 February and 22:00 on Sunday 15 February 2026.

2. Conditions of Approval E57 - Community Consultation on Respite

Condition of Approval E57 states: To undertake out-of-hours work outside the work hours specified under Condition E38, appropriate respite periods for the out-of-hours work must be identified in consultation with the community at each affected location on a regular basis. This consultation must include (but not be limited to) providing the community with:

- (a) a progressive schedule for periods no less than three (3) months, of likely out-of-hours work;
- (b) a description of the potential work, location, and duration of the out-of-hours work;
- (c) the noise characteristics and likely noise levels of the work; and
- (d) likely mitigation and management measures which aim to achieve the relevant noise management levels (NMLs) under Condition E43 (including the circumstances of when respite or relocation offers will be available and details about how the affected community can access these offers).

The outcomes of the community consultation, the identified respite periods and the scheduling of the likely out-of-hour work must be provided to the ER, EPA and the Planning Secretary prior to the out-of-hours work commencing.

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Note: Respite periods can be any combination of days or hours where out-of-hours work would not be more than 5 dB(A) above the RBL at any residence.

In accordance with the Sydney Metro Construction Noise and Vibration Standard (CNVS), the Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan (CNVMP), and the Detailed Noise and Vibration Impact Statements (DNVIS), all noise-affected receivers are eligible for respite periods during out-of-hours activities when works are predicted to exceed the Noise Management Levels (NMLs) during evening and night-time periods.

3.1 Hardcopy notification

The hardcopy notification was delivered by letterbox on Monday 24 November 2025, which detailed the OOHW to be carried out between: 1:00 on Saturday 14 February and 7:00 on Monday 16 February. Total letterboxes reached: 579.

An updated notification was delivered on 10 December to 18 properties that may be impacted by out of hours deliveries between 12am and 7am on Monday 5 and Monday 19 January that were not included in the original notification.

3.2 Online notification

A link to the online notification was emailed to the St Marys distribution list via the communications management system (Consultation Manager) and the Sydney Metro Connect app on Monday 24 November 2025. An updated notification was distributed by email and via the Sydney Metro Connect App on 11 December 2025.

3.3 OOHW three-month lookahead

A three-month OOHW lookahead is included in each monthly notification. The information below is proposed to be included in the March 2026 community notification to be distributed on 20 February 2026. The most recent community notification distributed was for three months from December 2025 to February 2026.

Planned night and weekend work

Subject to approvals, we will be working extended hours from:

- **6pm to 6am** between **Sunday 1 March** and **Friday 6 March** (five nights) and **Sunday 8 March** and **Friday 13 March** (five nights) to install platform tactile markers; and
- **7am to 3pm** on the following **Saturdays, 7 March, 14 March, 21 March** and **28 March**.

Our standard working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

Planned work outside of standard hours over the next three months

Planned activities (subject to approval) include excavation, structural steel, concrete, electrical and hydraulic, asphalt and landscaping work on the following dates:

Transport for NSW is delivering a new footbridge and northern plaza at St Marys Station as part of the Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project

Work activities in December to February

- installing steel, cladding, glass panels and roofing for the new footbridge
- building and fitting out new lifts and escalators
- installing drainage, electrical and other utility services
- footpath, landscaping and pavement work on Harris Street and near the multi-storey car park
- constructing the new Sydney Trains building
- delivering and removing materials and equipment via Hobart Street, Harris Street, Glossop Street, and Forrester Road.

What to expect

- two accessible parking spaces in the commuter car park will be temporarily unavailable to construct a new kerb ramp and related work
- up to 30 parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable on Harris Street for weekend work
- construction equipment in use will include excavators, saw cutters, trucks, cranes, concrete pumps, light towers, and tools.

Planned night and weekend work

Work will take place continuously during the following Sydney Trains trackwork weekends:

- **1am 29 November to 7am 1 December**
- **1am 20 December to 7am 22 December**
- **1am 10 January to 7am 12 January**
- **1am 14 February to 7am 16 February**

Subject to approvals, we will be working extended hours from:

- **6pm to 7am** between **Monday 5 January** and **Friday 30 January** (up to three nights per week)
- **6pm to 7am** between **Monday 2 February** and **Friday 27 February** (up to three nights per week)
- **7am to 3pm** on the following **Saturdays, 6 December, 13 December, 17 January, 24 January, 31 January** and **7 February.**

Building material and equipment will be delivered to our work areas between **6pm** and **6am** on **weeknights** from:

- **17 December to 22 December 2025**
- **7 January to 12 January 2026**
- **11 February to 16 February 2026**
- **18 February to 23 February 2026**
- **25 February to 2 March 2026.**

- managing vehicle and pedestrian access with traffic control and signs.



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
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

Respite offers for weekend work from Saturday 14 February to Monday 16 February and Saturday 21 February to Monday 23 February 2026

Transport for NSW is delivering a new footbridge and northern plaza at St Marys Station as part of the Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project.

For the following periods we will be working continuously during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork weekends:

- **1am Saturday 14 February to 7am Monday 16 February**
- **1am Saturday 21 February to 7am Monday 23 February.**

Planned activities include:

- installing steel, and parts for lifts, stairs and canopies
- resurfacing the platforms
- excavating in work areas
- investigating, installing and relocating utility services
- removing redundant infrastructure and services
- delivering and removing materials.

We will be working in multiple areas, including Harris Street, the station platforms and within the rail corridor. Work will also take place near the multi-storey commuter car park on Harris Street.

Laydown areas will be used to store construction materials and equipment and will be located within the rail corridor off Forrester Road, off Glossop Street and off Hobart Street.

Offer of respite

Where work is required outside standard construction hours, a noise assessment is prepared in accordance with the project's planning approval. We have done a noise assessment for the planned weekend work and understand there may be noisy work near your property. For this reason, we would like to offer you respite from the predicted noise impact of construction work in line with the Construction Noise and Vibration Standard on individual properties.

In line with the project's Detailed Noise and Vibration Impact Statement, each person in your household is eligible for five \$25 entertainment vouchers (for cinemas, Zone Bowling, or Timezone) for work occurring on **Saturday 14 February, Saturday 21 February and Sunday 22 February 2026.**
