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This E57 Community Consultation Report provides a summary of consultation undertaken in accordance with Condition of Approval (CoA) E57 with respect to Out-of-hours Work (OOHW) activities proposed at the Footbridge St Marys site.

OOHW is required to carry out activities within the rail corridor, which can only occur during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period. An OOHW application has been submitted to the Project Environmental Representative (ER) for approval before the work commences. The application includes a detailed outline of the construction activities, methodology, assessment of potential noise impacts, and a schedule of the required works.

The OOHW application will be reviewed and endorsed by the Sydney Metro Director of Project Communications and the Project Environmental Representative prior to works commencing.

1.1 OOHW activities include.

- Pile Break back - trimming of the piles to expose reinforcement bars to allow for capping beam construction.
- Hoarding removal at the beginning of the possession and hoarding reinstatement at the end of the possession.
- Bulk excavations on platforms
- FRP works for raft slab.
- Spoil removal from platforms.
- Mobilise materials on and off platforms.
- Asphalt rectification following completion of works platforms 1-4.

1.2 Laydown areas to be used.

- Harris St Compound to support the above activities and use of the site office, and materials storage.
- Laydown 1 (opposite Pacific National 20m south of Terminal Access Road) within the rail corridor to stockpile spoil. An excavator will manage material/plant as required at the laydown areas. All plant accessing from site compound, Glossop St, and Laydown area 1.
- Glossop St laydown.
- Hobart St laydowns (if required).

1.3 Work period

The proposed work will be carried out between 01:00 on Saturday 14 to 22:00 on Sunday 15 December 2024 during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period.

Previous E57 consultation reports have been submitted to the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) and Department of Planning, Housing, and Infrastructure (DPHI) and uploaded to the project webpage.

Mitigation measures to reduce noise impacts to receivers include the use of noise reduction blankets and attachments, orientation of plant and equipment away from receivers, and minimising the number of truck movements and equipment working at any one time outside of standard working hours.

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2. Conditions of Approval E57 - Community Consultation on Respite

Condition of Approval E57 states: In order to undertake out-of-hours work outside the work hours specified under Condition E38, appropriate respite periods for the out-of-hours work must be identified in consultation with the community at each affected location on a regular basis. This consultation must include (but not be limited to) providing the community with:

- (a) a progressive schedule for periods no less than three (3) months, of likely out-of-hours work;
- (b) a description of the potential work, location and duration of the out-of-hours work;
- (c) the noise characteristics and likely noise levels of the work; and
- (d) likely mitigation and management measures which aim to achieve the relevant noise management levels (NMLs) under Condition E43 (including the circumstances of when respite or relocation offers will be available and details about how the affected community can access these offers).

The outcomes of the community consultation, the identified respite periods and the scheduling of the likely out-of-hour work must be provided to the ER, EPA and the Planning Secretary prior to the out-of-hours work commencing.

Note: Respite periods can be any combination of days or hours where out-of-hours work would not be more than 5 dB(A) above the RBL at any residence.

In accordance with the Sydney Metro Construction Noise and Vibration Standard (CNVS), the Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan (CNVMP), and the Detailed Noise and Vibration Impact Statements (DNVIS), all noise-affected receivers are eligible for respite periods during out-of-hours activities when works are predicted to exceed the Noise Management Levels (NMLs) during evening and night-time periods.

2.1 Eligible properties

Respite has been triggered for Out of Hours Period 1(Standard & Evening) and Out of Hours Period 2 (Night) at the following properties:

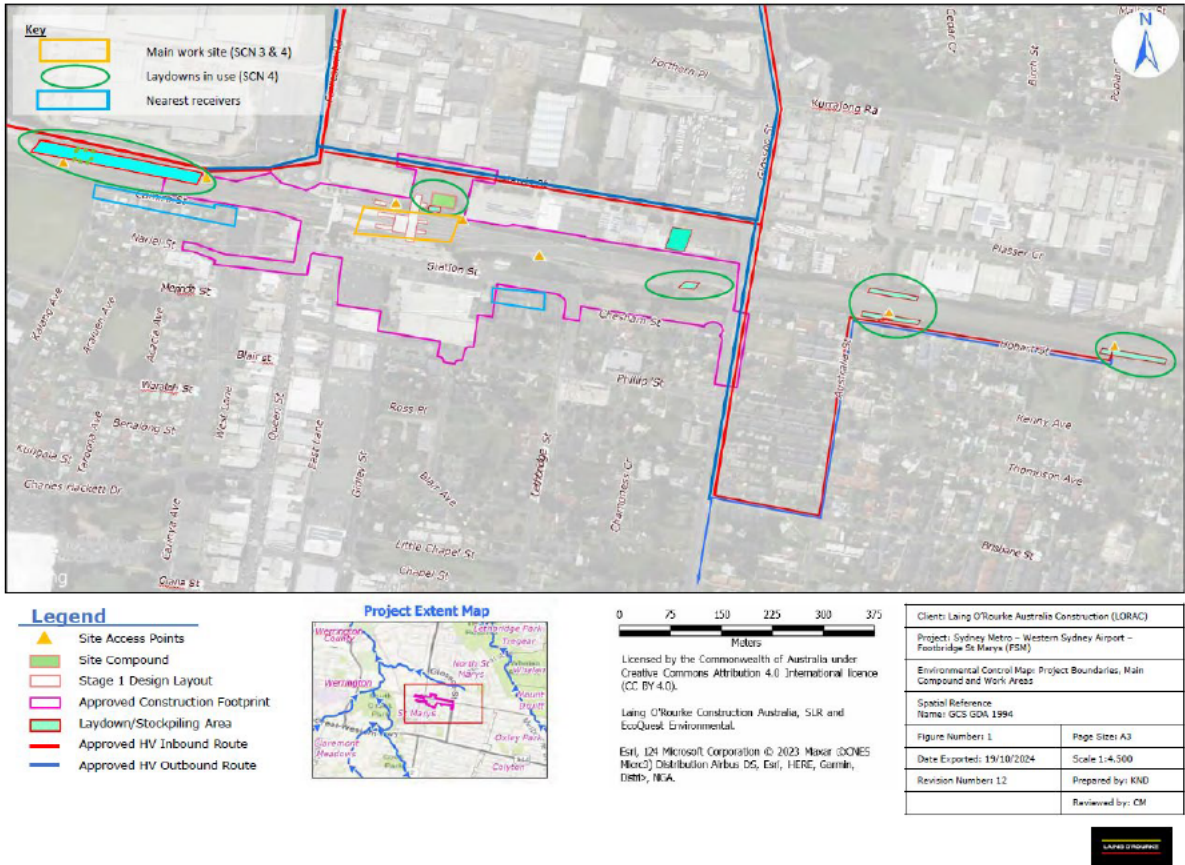

Residents will not be subjected to lengthy periods of noise and/or vibration impacts during the work from 01:00 Saturday 14th December until 22:00 Sunday 15th December 2024. Laing O'Rourke will mitigate impacts by applying the additional mitigation measures within the Sydney Metro Construction Noise and Vibration Strategy.

For works occurring on the station platforms Respite Offer (RO) will be offered up to 170m. For the use of Laydown 1 adjacent Terminal Access Road RO will be offered up to 100m from each laydown area. Please refer to the map on the next page which highlights the eligible properties.

3.1 Hardcopy notification

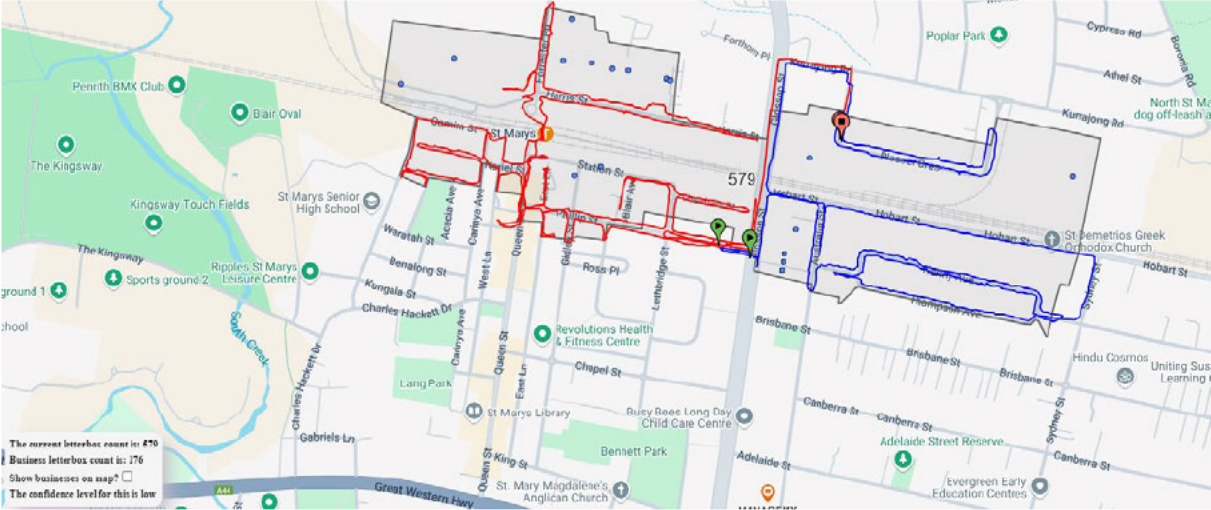
The hardcopy notification for work in December including OOHW from 01:00 Saturday 14th December 2024 until 22:00 Sunday 15th December 2024 was delivered by letterbox on 25.11.2024.

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Total letterboxes reached: 579.



3.1.1 Map key

The grey shaded area indicates the distribution zone, encompassing a 200-meter radius around the work and laydown areas.

The red line represents the GPS-tracked route; properties along this route received a hardcopy of the monthly community notification.

Transport for NSW is delivering a new footbridge and northern plaza at St Marys Station as part of the Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project.

What work are we doing?

During **December 2024** and **January 2025**, work activities will include:

- Delivering and removing materials and equipment to and from our work and laydown areas on Hobart Street, Harris Street, Glossop Street, and end of Forrester Road
- Electrical, excavation and concrete work on all platforms
- Excavation and concrete work within the site compound on Harris Street
- Utility service investigation work on Harris Street and around the multi-storey car park
- Crane and lifting operations within the Harris Street work area and on platforms.

Weekend work in December and January:

In December, some work will take place continuously during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend. Weekend work will occur from **1am Saturday 14 December** until **10pm Sunday 15 December**. Activities during these weekends include:

- removing and delivering materials
- concreting and excavation work
- electrical work.

What to expect:

- An increase in workers and vehicles around work sites and laydown areas, and on the station platforms, especially during our weekend work.
- Traffic control and signage as required.
- There will be an increase in noise and vibration from construction machinery and equipment operating behind the construction hoarding on all platforms.

Managing our impacts:

We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts on the community and the environment. The site compound is designed with this in mind, and we achieve it by:

- installing fencing for safety and security
- reducing our noise as much as possible by turning off machinery when not in use and using temporary noise barriers where feasible.

Equipment to be used:

Equipment includes drills, demolition saws, excavators, saw cutters, dump trucks, front end loaders, vacuum trucks, semi-trailers and rigid trucks, concrete pumps, concrete trucks, mobile crane, light towers, power tools, survey equipment and hand tools.

Planned work outside of standard hours over the next three months:

Work activities including excavation, piling, concrete work, electrical work, and removal of materials are planned for the following weekends (subject to approval):

- **1am Saturday 14 December** until **10pm Sunday 15 December 2024**
- **1am Saturday 11 January** until **1am Monday 13 January 2025**
- **1am Saturday 22 February** until **1am Monday 24 February 2025**

When and where we'll be working:

Standard working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm, Saturdays**. Our work and laydown areas are shown on the maps over the page.

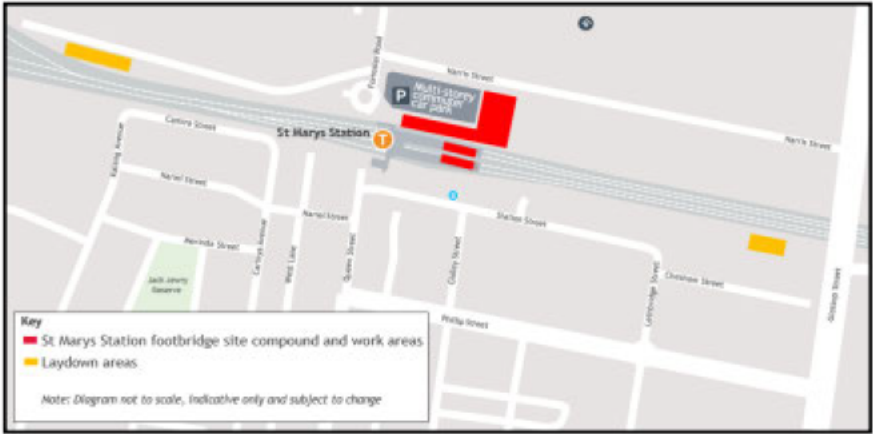

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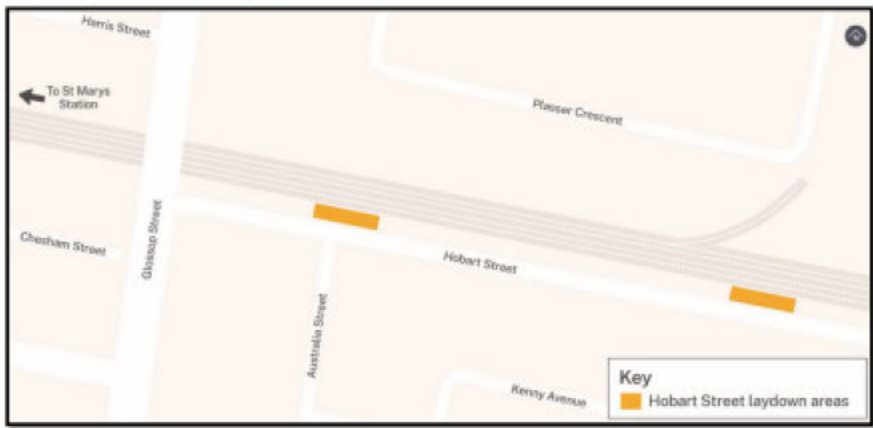
