This E57 Community Consultation Report provides a summary of consultation undertaken in accordance with Condition of Approval (CoA) E57 with respect to Out-of-hours Work (OOHW) activities proposed at the Footbridge St Marys site.

OOHW is required to carry out activities within the rail corridor, which can only occur during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period. An OOHW application has been submitted to the Project Environmental Representative (ER) for approval before the work commences. The application includes a detailed outline of the construction activities, methodology, assessment of potential noise impacts, and a schedule of the required works.

The OOHW application will be reviewed and endorsed by the Sydney Metro Director of Project Communications and the Project Environmental Representative prior to works commencing.

1.1 OOHW activities include.

- Excavating and backfilling in work areas
- Asphalt reinstatement
- Resurfacing station platforms
- Investigating, installing and relocating utility services
- Installing steel, lift glazing, soffits and canopies
- Concrete patching and painting
- Removing redundant infrastructure and services
- Excavating, reinforcement tying and installing formwork in the Northern Plaza
- Delivery and removal of equipment and materials.
- Harris St Compound (32-34 Harris St), Harris Street laydown (2 Harris Street) and Glossop St laydown will be utilised to support the above activities, use of the site office, and materials storage and stockpiling.
- All plant accessing from Glossop Street laydown and Harris St compound.

1.2 Work period.

The proposed works will be carried out during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork periods between 01:00 on Saturday 18 April and 07:00 on Monday 20 April 2026.

2. Conditions of Approval E57 - Community Consultation on Respite

Condition of Approval E57 states: To undertake out-of-hours work outside the work hours specified under Condition E38, appropriate respite periods for the out-of-hours work must be identified in consultation with the community at each affected location on a regular basis. This consultation must include (but not be limited to) providing the community with:

- (a) a progressive schedule for periods no less than three (3) months, of likely out-of-hours work;
- (b) a description of the potential work, location, and duration of the out-of-hours work;
- (c) the noise characteristics and likely noise levels of the work; and
- (d) likely mitigation and management measures which aim to achieve the relevant noise management levels (NMLs) under Condition E43 (including the circumstances of when respite or relocation offers will be available and details about how the affected community can access these offers).

The outcomes of the community consultation, the identified respite periods and the scheduling of the likely out-of-hour work must be provided to the ER, EPA and the Planning Secretary prior to the out-of-hours work commencing.

Note: Respite periods can be any combination of days or hours where out-of-hours work would not be more than 5 dB(A) above the RBL at any residence.

Transport for NSW is delivering a new footbridge and northern plaza at St Marys Station as part of the Sydney Metro–Western Sydney Airport project

Work activities in April

- installing steel, cladding, glass panels and roofing for the new footbridge
- building and fitting out new lifts and escalators
- installing hydraulic, electrical, mechanical, fire and other utility services
- footpath, landscaping and pavement work on Harris Street and near the multi-storey car park
- constructing the new Sydney Trains building
- resurfacing station platforms and installing tactile makers
- delivering and removing materials and equipment via Hobart Street, Harris Street, Glossop Street, and Forrester Road.

What to expect

- in the multi-storey commuter car park:
 - two accessible parking spaces in the commuter car park remain unavailable to provide safe space for work activities in the new plaza area
 - up to six additional parking spaces, including five accessible spaces, may be temporarily unavailable between **Friday 10 April** and **Wednesday 15 April** to build the new bicycle shelter as contingency in case of wet weather.
- up to 16 parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable on Harris Street for weekend work, night work and deliveries.
- construction equipment in use will include excavators, saw cutters, trucks, cranes, concrete pumps, light towers, and tools.

Planned night and weekend work

In **April**, work on the new footbridge and station platforms will take place continuously during the following planned Sydney Trains trackwork weekend:

- **1am Saturday 18 April to 7am Monday 20 April.**

Subject to approvals, we will be working extended hours from:

- **7am to 3pm on Saturday 11 April and Saturday 25 April.**
- **6pm to 6am between Tuesday 28 April and Saturday 2 May and Monday 4 May to Saturday 9 May** to install platform tactile markers.

Our standard working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**

Managing our impacts

We aim to minimise impacts on the community and environment by:

- installing safety and security fencing around our work areas
- reducing noise by turning off machinery when not in use
- managing vehicle and pedestrian access with traffic control and signs.

Planned work outside of standard hours over the next three months

Planned activities (subject to approval) include excavation, structural|steel, concrete, electrical and hydraulic, asphalt and landscaping work on the following dates:

- Saturday 30 May to Monday 1 June
- Saturday 18 July to Monday 20 July
- Saturday 25 July to Monday 27 July.

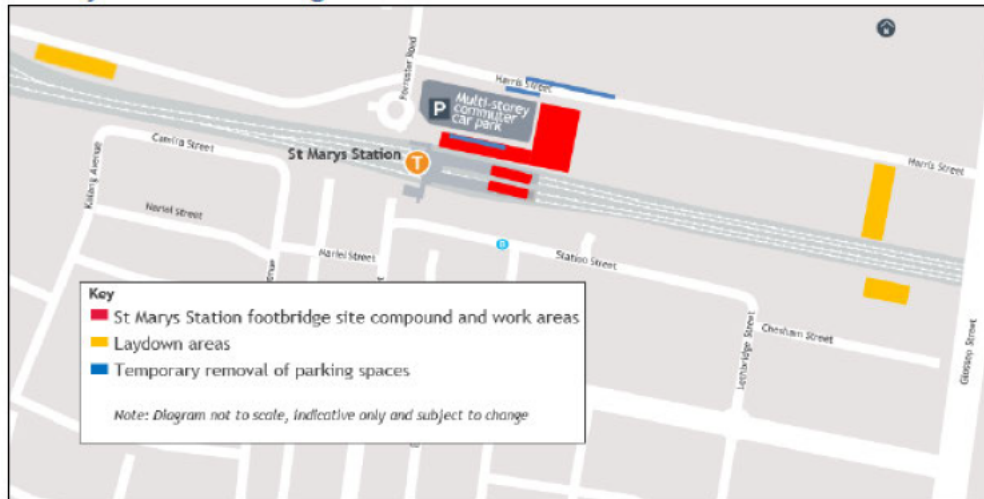

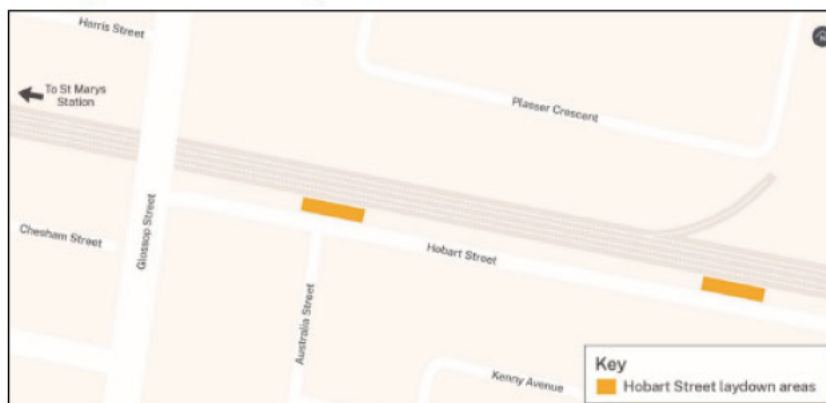

Transport for NSW is delivering a new footbridge and northern plaza at St Marys Station as part of the Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project.

For the following periods we will be working continuously during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork weekend, from 1am Saturday 18 April to 7am Monday 20 April.

Planned activities include:

- installing glass panels and footbridge building work
- fitting out lifts and escalators
- resurfacing the station platforms
- excavating in work areas
- installing and relocating utility services
- delivering and removing materials.

We will be working in multiple areas, including Harris Street, the station platforms and within the rail corridor. Work will also take place near the multi-storey commuter car park on Harris Street.

Laydown areas will be used to store construction materials and equipment and will be located within the rail corridor off Forrester Road and off Glossop Street.

Offer of respite

Where work is required outside standard construction hours, a noise assessment is prepared in accordance with the project's planning approval. We have carried out a noise impact assessment for the planned weekend work and understand there may be noisy work near your property. For this reason, we would like to offer you respite from the predicted noise impact of construction work in line with the Construction Noise and Vibration Standard on individual properties.

In line with the project's Detailed Noise and Vibration Impact Statement, each person in your household is eligible for three \$25 entertainment vouchers (for cinemas, Zone Bowling, or Timezone) for work occurring on Saturday 18 April and Sunday 19 April 2026.
